

## **BSAC Megalodon Rebreather Statement**

From May 1<sup>st</sup> 2006, the BSAC recognised the International Association of Nitrox and Technical Divers (IANTD) courses for the Megalodon closed circuit rebreather.

BSAC members who hold a recognised **Closed Circuit Rebreather** certification for the Megalodon rebreather may take part in BSAC dives to a maximum of 40 metres with air diluent, with a maximum planned in-water accumulative decompression of 10 minutes and within the BSAC Safe Diving.

BSAC members who hold a recognised **Normoxic Trimix Closed Circuit Rebreather** certification for the Megalodon rebreather may take part in BSAC dives within the limits set by their certification and BSAC Safe Diving, which ever is the lesser limit.

BSAC members who hold a recognised **Trimix Closed Circuit Rebreather Diver** Certification for the Megalodon rebreather may take part in BSAC dives to a maximum depth of 80 metres whilst using trimix as a diluent gas and within BSAC Safe Diving.
